COVID-19 and HFMA Certification Maintenance

During this unprecedented time HFMA is committed to meeting the need of its certified individuals. HFMA is implementing a certification maintenance grace period to allow for additional time to meet the recertification requirements. For those due to maintain their certification by May 31, 2020 the deadline will be extended from May 31, 2020 to October 1, 2020.

For CHFP and FHFMA certificants

In addition to active membership, to retain your certified status with HFMA, you must report/participate in 60 contact hours of eligible education activity (over a 3-year period) and record those activities in the HFMA Online Reporting Tool by October 1, 2020.

For CRCR and Certified Specialist certificants

To retain your certified status with HFMA, you must successfully complete the Certified Specialist recertification assessment. Registration and access to the recertification materials will be available through October 1, 2020.

HFMA will work with individuals on a case-by-case basis if they are unable to meet the requirement by the extended due date.

You have worked hard to earn your certification and we understand maintenance is important – it demonstrates professional continuing competence and a comprehensive understanding of the business environment.
